government officials (No Gift Policy)
Fiscal year 2024

Organic Act on Prevention and Suppression of Corruption B.E. 2018, Section 128
No government official is allowed to Receive property or any other benefits which may be calculated as income from anyone other than property or reasonable benefits according to laws, rules or regulations issued by virtue of the provisions of the law. Except for receiving property or any other benefits through good conduct according to the criteria and amounts specified by the NACC. In addition, the Cabinet resolution on December 8, 2020 approved the national reform plan for preventing and suppressing corruption. and misconduct (revised edition) By specifying that there will be a drive to carry out important reform activities (Big Rock) Reform activity number 4 Develop the Thai bureaucracy To be transparent and without profit, goal 1, item 1.1 “Let all government agencies declare themselves to be agencies where all government officials do not accept gifts. and all kinds of gifts from performing duties (No Gift Policy)”

To promote measures to prevent corruption and misconduct in the government sector. and is an expression of the spirit of fighting against all forms of corruption. Including strengthening the culture and honest values to perform work with morality, ethics and without conflicts of interest.
